
1. Report in brief by Organizer / Coordinator / Convener:

On 8 August 2019, due to heavy rainfall in the Monsoon season, severe flood affected the southern Indian State of Kerala. As a security measure in the prevailing situation of heavy rains, the Government of Kerala had issued Red alert in the 9 districts in Northern and Central Kerala, orange alert in 3 districts of Central Kerala, and yellow alert in the 2 districts of southern Kerala. Thousands of people have been evacuated to safer places and relief camps. A total of 101 people have died due to rain-related incidents since 14 August 2019, These camps now host more than 2 lakh people from various parts of the state.

As of 14 August 2019, 121 people have been killed due to the floods across the state of Kerala. Over 2 lakh people have been directly affected by the flood, and have been shifted to 1318 relief camps in different parts of Kerala. The data from the Kerala State Disaster Management states that, as many as 1,789 houses had been damaged fully in between 8 and 19 August, while the number of partially damaged houses is 14,542. In order to bring awareness among students to help others RCE established Kerala Relief Fund and collected donations from students of all years from I year to Final Year.

In this regard RCEE Management, Students and Staff donated Rs1,03,189 to Kerala Relief Fund.








1. Report

On 12 December 2017, The Department of S &H of Ramachandra College of Engineering, Eluru conducted a programme on Subhas Chandra Bose. He was born on 23 January 1897 in Cuttack, Orissa Division, Bengal Province, to Prabhavati Dutt Bose and Janakinath Bose. He was admitted to the Protestant European School (presently Stewart High School) in Cuttack, like his brothers and sisters, in January 1902. After securing the second position in the matriculation examination in 1913, he was admitted to the Presidency College where he studied briefly. He was influenced by the teachings of Swami Vivekananda and Ramakrishna after reading their works at the age of 16. He felt that his religion was more important than his studies.

His nationalistic temperament came to light when he was expelled for assaulting Professor Oaten (who had manhandled some Indian students) for the latter's anti-India comments. He was expelled although he appealed that he only witnessed the assault and did not actually participate in it. He later joined the Scottish Church College at the University of Calcutta and passed his B.A. in 1918 in philosophy. Bose left India in 1919 for England with a promise to his father that he would appear in the Indian Civil Services (ICS) examination. He went to study in Fitzwilliam College, Cambridge and matriculated on 19 November 1919. He came fourth in the ICS examination and was selected, but he did not want to work under an alien government which would mean serving the British. As he stood on the verge of taking the plunge by resigning from the Indian Civil Service in 1921, he wrote to his elder brother Sarat Chandra Bose: "Only on the soil of sacrifice and suffering can we raise our national edifice."He resigned from his civil service job on 23 April 1921 and returned to India.

Our principal Dr. Dola Sanjay motivated the students about the life of Subhas Chandra Bose, his patriotism towards the country. The programme concluded with National Anthem.

infectious disease.






FIND OUT THE PROBLEMS :-

Since many mosquitoes breed in standing water, source reduction can be as simple as emptying water from containers around the home. This is something that homeowners can accomplish. We can eliminate mosquito breeding grounds at home by removing unused plastic pools, old tires, or buckets, by clearing clogged gutters and repairing leaks around faucets, by regularly (at most every 4 days) changing water in bird baths, and by filling or draining puddles, swampy areas, and tree stumps. Eliminating such mosquito breeding areas can be an extremely effective and permanent way to reduce mosquito populations without resorting to insecticides.

Open water marsh management involves the use of shallow ditches, to create a network of water flow within marshes and to connect the marsh to a pond or canal. The network of ditches drains the mosquito habitat and lets in fish which will feed on mosquito larvae. This reduces the need for other control methods such as pesticides. Simply giving the predators access to the mosquito larvae can result in long-term mosquito control.

Suggestions for how to avoid mosquito bites:-

- 1. Wear mosquito repellent
- 2. Consider an all-natural solution.
- Wear loose, long-sleeved shirts and long pants when outdoors.
- Don't waste money on an electric hanging bug"Zapper."
- 5. Sleep with a mosquito net over your bed.
- 6. Avoid standing water.
- 7. Grab the mosquito out of the air.


Day 5 (6th June 2016):
